Kumpal Mittal designed the residence with an abundance of warmth that comes through wood and plywood. Panelling, veneers, textures and colours play a major role in creating the ideal ambience in each room. She says, "In the living room, we opted for a horizontal wooden panelling on an entire wall to create a pattern. The same technique also camouflaged the kitchen door." In the master bedroom, the use of textured wood horizontally continues on the headboard, while an embossed effect on the cupboards lends a fusion design element. In the son's room, veneer finished with white lacquer was employed for contrast and variety.
